- Use the Table of Contents to quickly navigate the book
- Download the chapter to PDF for offline reading
- Print, save, cite, email or share (via social networks) the chapter
 - Carry out a search within the book
 - Find alternative ways to access the book

Saving links with your personalisation options

Citing a book in Oxford Medicine Online

Oxford Medicine Online can export citations to EndNote[™], ReferenceManager[™], ProCite[™], RefWorks[™], Zotero[™] and BibTex[™].

Click on the pencil icon in the toolbar to launch the Citation Export window

- 2 Select the required export format (MLA, APA, or Chicago) from the drop down list and click **Export**
- 3 You can also preview and copy and paste from selected formats
