QUALITY STUDIES

The curriculum and the teaching in the Medicine program are based on Problem Based Learning and it provides the most effective and modern way to acquire required competences. The internal quality assurance is based on three major aspects – the quality of the curriculum, high competence of teaching staff and student orientated learning process. The curriculum is in full conformance with EU Directive for regulated professions (Directive 2005/36/EC) and the study process complies with Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG2015). Conformance with the standards is evaluated every 7 years by the national quality agency (Center for Quality Assessment in Higher Education) and an international expert team assuring full reliability of the study process quality surveillance. The compliance with WFME standards is assured through awarding recognition status by WFME to the national quality agency.

Duration – 6 years

STUDY PROGRAMME SUMMARY

I year

Introduction to profession: Understanding of Health Care System, Concept and Contexts of Professionalism, Observational Practice, Medical Terminology and Speciality Language, Basics of Professional Skills. **Basic Sciences:** Cell Biology and Biochemistry, Genetics, Embryology, Introduction to Anatomy, Body Tissues, Interaction of Organism and Environment, Response to Environmental Effects and Structural Homeostasis.

II–III years

Integrated (structure, function, main pathological processes) PBL modules: Skeletal, Joint, Muscular System, Nerves, Perception and Sensation, Circulation, Respiration, Digestive System, Kidney and Homeostasis, Endocrine and Reproductive System. Essentials of Clinical Studies, Radiology, Pharmacology. Main clinical skills and Procedures. Medical Ethics and Human Rights in Medicine.

IV–VI years

Clinical Studies and Practice, Master Thesis: Clinical Modules, Internship, Master Thesis



PRACTICE IN LITHUANIA AND ABROAD

Studies of the most important clinical subjects take place in Kaunas clinics. Practical skills are gained in the hospital, through the practice of special medical modules, and in the sixth year of study – during clinical medicine practice. It is also possible to practice abroad: agreements have been signed with foreign hospitals. *ERASMUS+* and other exchange programs give possibilities to study or practice in foreign universities and clinics.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

After completing medical degree programme, graduates are eligible to apply for the license of a medical doctor, which allows to practice primary medicine independently or work in a team with other doctors.

Take your next step in your medical career at LSMU postgraduate training which refers to a qualified physician. LSMU offers 63 accredited residency programmes to fit your specialty and interest. You can also choose a research career and continue studies in PhD.
