STUDY PROGRAMME SUMMARY

I year	Cell Biology and Parasitology, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Latin and Lithuanian languages, Human Anatomy, Human Histology and Embryology, Physiology, Oral Microbiology.
II year	Preclinical courses of dental and oral diseases, where clinical skills are being developed in phantom-head laboratories.
III year	Prevention of Dental Diseases, Prosthetic Odontology, Clinical Cariesology, Oral Surgery, as well as starting to work with the PATIENTS, Pharmacology, Internal diseases, Anesthesiology and Intensive Care.
IV year	Paediatric Dentistry, Periodontology and Orthodontics, Radiology, Otorhinolaryngologic Pathology. Clinical Practice in 5 specialized dental departments.
V years	Research work, Master thesis , integrated internship.

I year	Natural Sciences, Human Anatomy, Dental Hygienist's Professional Health, Psychology of Communication, Lithuanian Language.
II year	Physiology, Oral Health and Personal Oral Hygiene, Ethics, Ergonomics, Phantom Course in Professional Dental Hygiene.
III year	Professional Dental Hygiene and Clinical Practice, Cariology and Clinical Practice, Periodontology and Clinical Practice, Oral Surgery: pain control, Pharmacology, Radiology, Prevention of Oral Diseases.
IV year	Clinical Practice, Paediatric Dentistry and Clinical Practice, Oral Health Care of Elderly People, Oral Health Care of Orthodontic Patients, Introduction into Prosthetic Dentistry.
