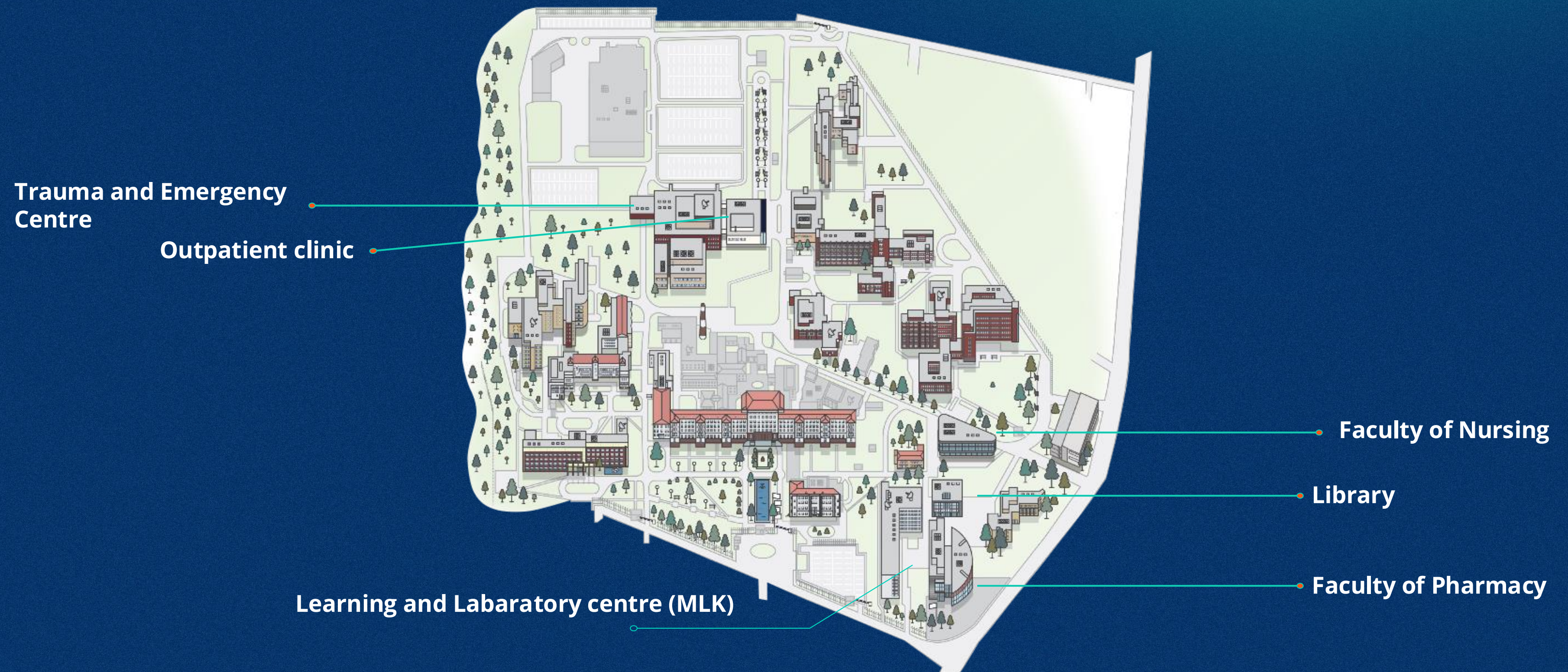

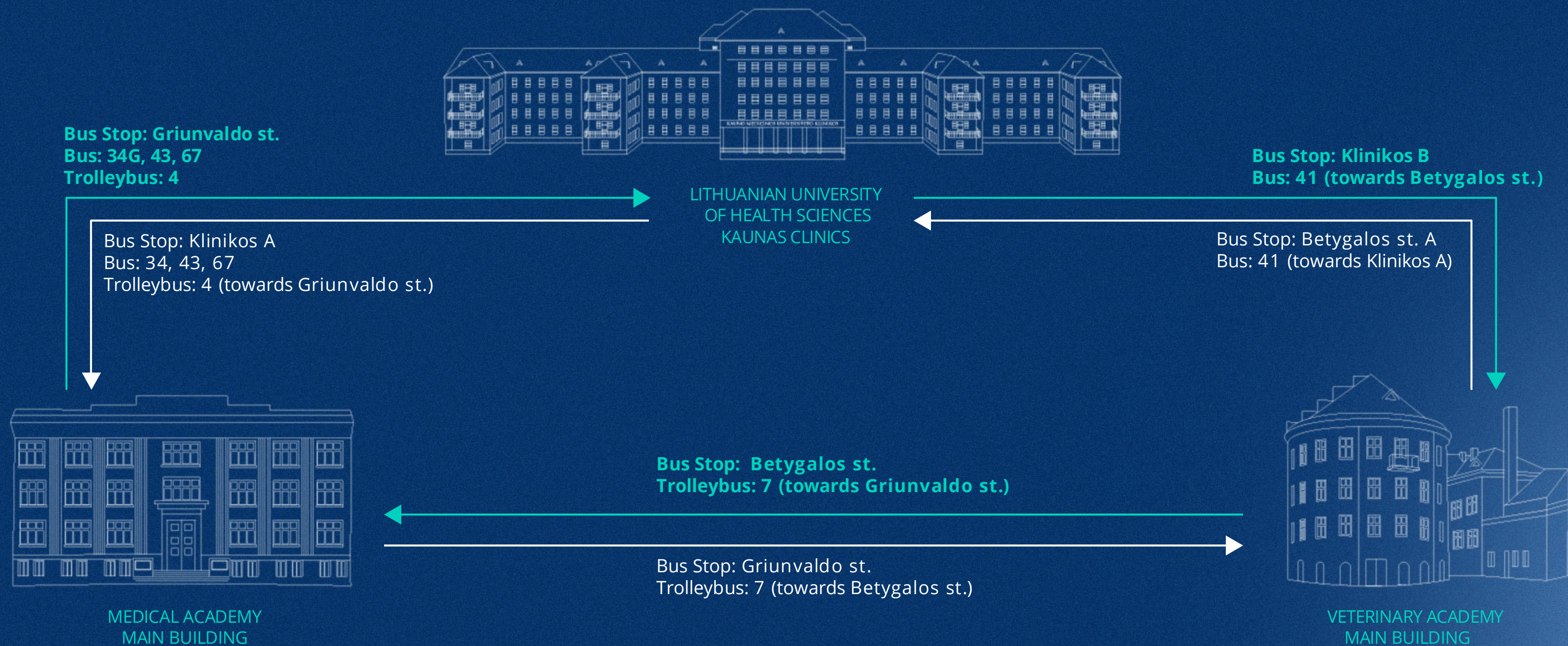
8.1 KAUNAS CLINICS MAP

11 SPECIAL LEARNING NEEDS AND DISABILITIES

The University creates an open and friendly study environment for all students, and it aims to meet the individual needs of students by increasing access to studies and fosters a culture of equality and non-discrimination.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Students with a legally established participation level of 45% or lower (*formerly referred to as a working capacity level until 31 December 2023*), or a severe or moderate disability, may be eligible for financial support.

- Non-EU/EEA citizens must have a valid Temporary Residence Permit (TRP) to open a bank account in Lithuania.

QUALITY OF STUDIES AND ASSESSMENT OF STUDY ACHIEVEMENTS

Studies at LSMU are performed through contact and mixed learning. Completion of the study program and study plan (participation in contact hours classes) is mandatory for students.

QUALITY OF STUDIES

Students are encouraged to be active participants in the study process and contribute to improving the quality of studies by participating in meetings, interviews, and filling out feedback surveys.

ASSESSMENT OF STUDY ACHIEVEMENTS

In case of more than 25% absence from classes, the student will be required to retake the module.

The exam results or other student achievement evaluations are uploaded to LSMUSIS within 5 working days after the evaluation.

Appeals may be submitted via LSMUSIS. It regarding:

- **Results of the assessment within 3 business days** from the publication of the results.
- **Results of the examination within 3 business day** from the publication of the results
- **Evaluation procedures within 3 business days** from the implementation of the evaluation

A student who has failed an exam, homework, project, or other form of evaluation, has the right to retake it twice, free of charge but no later than by the end of the current study year, i.e., August 31st.

17 GROUP AND COURSE MONITORS

By the middle of September, each group must choose its group monitor. Later, group monitors choose a monitor who represents the entire course.

IMPORTANT! Monitors do not receive the monitor's scholarship.

- A monitor is the main representative of their group or course.
- The term for a monitor is one academic year (however, usually the same person remains a monitor throughout all study years).
- The group monitor cooperates with the course monitor, lecturers, LSMU SA (or ICOSA), University administration, and other University institutions.
- Group monitor must provide their contact information to LSMU SA (or ICOSA).
- The group monitor must convey to the group all relevant information related to the study quality and process, as well as know the most important documents - the Study Regulations and the University Statute.
- The group monitor mediates the coordination of schedules when necessary.
- We recommend that every new monitor takes part in the "Monitors training" organized by LSMU SA International Committee - these monitors get familiar with the University structure and documents.
