Duration – 4 years Degree – Bachelor of Social Sciences

WHY HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY?

This study programme provides an opportunity to gain a solid foundation in psychology and related social and natural sciences, and get ready for practical work with people. Health psychology analyses how biology, behavior, thoughts and emotions influence human health and related outcomes. You will learn to understand how and why people behave and feel the way they do, how personality develops, and finally, what human beings can do to stay psychologically and physically healthy.



Health psychology is uniquely positioned to help people change the behaviors contributing to health and well-being, also avoid risky or unhealthy behavior and maintain a positive outlook that can combat stress, depression and anxiety.

WHAT KIND OF WORK DO HEALTH PSYCHOLOGISTS DO?

Health psychologists often conduct behavioral assessments, clinical interviews and personality tests. Other tasks involve educating and teaching people how to avoid unhealthy behaviors as well as providing psychological counseling to patients with somatic diseases. Rehabilitation, assistance to patients and medical personnel, preparation of public health promotion programmes, participation in health policy and improvement of the health care system are also important tasks that a health psychologist can carry out. A health psychologist can work in primary health care sector, in specialized clinics, in mental health, crisis or rehabilitation centers, in social care and welfare institutions, and many other private or public institutions.

CLINICAL HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY

Duration – 2 years Degree – Master of Social Sciences

Clinical Health Psychology is a specialized programme which combines clinical and health psychology teaching with research methods training and practice. The programme aims to prepare competent psychologists with good knowledge in health, health disorders and health care systems characteristics, being able to work in interdisciplinary teams, to use scientific arguments and effectively apply suitable methods in fields of clinical health psychology. Students have opportunities to specialize in oncopsychology, neuropsychology, rehabilitation psychology or child and family psychology.

Students learn and practice psychological counselling and clinical psychological assessment, improve communication and collaboration with other health care specialists. Moreover, students have a chance to choose one of the 4 possible specializations: Onco-psychology, Neuropsychology, Children and family psychology and Rehabilitation psychology. A graduated Bachelor's degree in Psychology is required to be eligible to study Clinical Health Psychology. In the third semester students have possibility to practice in Lithuania or abroad, as well as apply for funding and spend a semester abroad with the Erasmus+ exchange programme. Diploma is recognized in the EU. The programme is prepared according to the EuroPsy requirements.

STUDY PROGRAMME SUMMARY


Lifestyle Medicine study programme covers a modern approach to changing lifestyle (diet, physical activity, risky behaviour, psycho-emotional resilience, social environment) to prevent diseases, control chronic diseases, and act on their causes.

The study programme provides evidence-based competencies for the prevention of non-communicable diseases. Students are trained by the most prominent specialists in professional counselling of healthy nutrition, ph vironmental, lifestyle, psychological and biological health risk factors for the best possible intervention plan or algorithm.

Introduction to Lifestyle Medicine, Epidemiology of Chronic and Communicable Diseases, Public Health, Nutrition, Physical Activity and Health, Mental Health and Lifestyle, Research Work in Lifestyle Medicine, Elective Courses, Master Theses Preparation.

BLENDED LEARNING (online and onsite)

Blended learning curricula combines onsite and distant learning: brief 1–2-week onsite visits are organized (2-3 times per study year) with traditional methods of contact learning; the rest of study time is being utilized online, with educational material provided, through the interaction with course instructors. Online studies are organized via "Moodle" platform.

During the distant study sessions, students will be provided with all the necessary study material: online lectures, broadcasts, and other forms of studying. During the on-site visits to the University students will get the possibility to train and apply their theoretical knowledge in practice...

APPLIED PUBLIC HEALTH

MASTER DEGREE

Duration – 2 years Degree – Master of Health Sciences

The degree programme Applied Public Health aims to provide competencies for students wishing to pursue a career in public and private health sectors as well as in non-governmental organizations. The MPH degree is the most widely recognized professional credentials for leadership in public health. The programme is intended for graduates already holding a bachelor's or master's degree, who are seeking to broaden their understanding and knowledge in the field of public health.

It offers a unique opportunity to acquire TWO MASTER DIPLOMAS during 2 years of studies in TWO COUNTRIES.





ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The programme is offered for students already enrolled in the Applied Public Health in Kaunas in LSMU. Students for this joint venture are selected by joint Selection Board during the first semester (September-October) studies in LSMU.


