Rules for using the LSMU Prayer Room

- 1. The Prayer Room is always open to students and employees of the University community, but it cannot be reserved for celebrations or group study.
- 2. The Prayer Room is intended for contemplation, prayer and meditation, therefore eating, drinking, talking, listening to music, using the telephone or sleeping is prohibited.
- 3. Praying loudly or in groups can only be done if it does not disturb other people in the room.
- 4. If there are other people in the room, it is permitted entering the room and using it according to one's own faith.
- 5. You may use symbols and texts of your faith. You may bring what you need. Upon departure, please take with you what you have brought.
- 6. Please do not use incense, scents due to potential allergies or sensitivities to smell. Burning fire or candles is prohibited.
- 7. Please take your shoes off in the dedicated area of the room.
- 8. The activities at the room must meet the values of the University, which include equality of gender, cultural, faith and beliefs.
