

Rules for using the LSMU Prayer Room

1. The Prayer Room is always open to students and employees of the University community, but it cannot be reserved for celebrations or group study.
2. The Prayer Room is intended for contemplation, prayer and meditation, therefore eating, drinking, talking, listening to music, using the telephone or sleeping is prohibited.
3. Praying loudly or in groups can only be done if it does not disturb other people in the room.
4. If there are other people in the room, it is permitted entering the room and using it according to one's own faith.
5. You may use symbols and texts of your faith. You may bring what you need. Upon departure, please take with you what you have brought.
6. Please do not use incense, scents due to potential allergies or sensitivities to smell. Burning fire or candles is prohibited.
7. Please take your shoes off in the dedicated area of the room.
8. The activities at the room must meet the values of the University, which include equality of gender, cultural, faith and beliefs.
