

Information about Issuing the Temporary Residence Permit (TRP)

Full-time degree students from non-EU countries:

You are required to apply for a Temporary Residence Permit (TRP).

1. VALID TRAVEL DOCUMENT (PASSPORT)

2. REGISTER FOR MEDIATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY

To apply for your TRP, you must register through the university.

- It is usually issued within 7 days. Once issued, the mediation number will be emailed to you.

3. BANK STATEMENT

(in Lithuanian or English) (from 1 January 2026 – **at least 6918 EUR**)

4. HEALTH INSURANCE

* Health insurance must conform to such requirements: The insurance must guarantee the payment of emergency medical care services, as they are defined in the Law of Health Care System of the Republic of Lithuania, and expenses that could emerge due to the alien's return to the foreign country for health related reasons (transportation, including, the accompanying of health care specialist(s) and The insurance must be valid for the whole duration of the requested temporary residence permit or for at least one year.

5. CERTIFICATE REGARDING CONVICTION/NON-CONVICTION

*You are required to provide a certificate from the country (or countries) where you have resided for the past 2 years before arriving to Lithuania. The document must be legalized and/or certified with an Apostille or a Secondary stamp from the Ministry of Foreign affairs of Lithuania. The certificates must be issued no earlier than 6 months prior to the submission of the TRP application.

6. AN UNDERTAKING (CONFIRMATION) THAT YOU WILL DECLARE YOUR PLACE OF RESIDENCE IN KAUNAS

*You will confirm this by checking the checkbox when filling out the application via MIGRIS

7. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

Submit your application via www.migracija.lt

8. THE PUBLIC FEE (issue of the TRP):

Based on the general procedure – **160.00 EUR**

Note:

- If a student loses their legal status, their studies will be immediately suspended, and they will be required to leave Lithuania and reapply for a TRP from their home country.
