If you are an EU/EEA citizen and have come and live in the Republic of Lithuania for more than 3 months in half a year, you have to apply for a certificate confirming your right of temporary residence (TRC) in the Republic of Lithuania.

## FOR EU/EEA STUDENTS

## FORMALITIES FOR EU/EEA CITIZENS AFTER ARRIVAL TO LITHUANIA

After arrival students who come for a longer that 90 days period have to:

- register in Migration Office in order to get document certifying your legal stay in Lithuania.
- declare the living place in Municipality Office (lt. Seniūnija).

## **REGISTRATION PROCEDURE IN MIGRATION OFFICE**

You need to present following documents to Kaunas Migration Office (address: Juozapavičiaus pr. 57, Kaunas)

- 1. A valid passport or ID card.
- 2. European health insurance card or private insurance in English or in Lithuanian language.
- Certificate regarding enrolment at LSMU (you will get it from the Study Center); <u>https://lsmusis.lsmuni.lt</u> – Application – Personal details – Del leidimo gyventi LR - SUBMIT
- 4. Declaration that you have sufficient resources to support yourself in English or in Lithuanian language. (Resources may come from your parents, spouse, university, government etc., at least 425 EU/month).
- 5. The public fee 8,60 euro. (Pay by the bank card in the Migration Office).
- 6. An application form (submit your application and documents for the issue of the certificate in person through the Lithuanian Migration Information System MIGRIS: <u>www.migracija.lt</u> Login Email New application Applications on behalf of natural persons Select your nationality I want to get a temporary residence certificate

## **MORE INFORMATION**

- Within 5 working days Migration Office will prepare the document certifying your legal stay in Lithuania and will post it to your living address in Lithuania.
- After reception of this document, you must declare your living place within 7 working days at the Municipality Office.
