FOR EU/EEA STUDENTS

If you are an EU/EEA citizen and have come and live in the Republic of Lithuania for more than 3 months in half a year, you have to apply for a certificate confirming your right of temporary residence (TRC) in the Republic of Lithuania.

FORMALITIES FOR EU/EEA CITIZENS AFTER ARRIVAL TO LITHUANIA

After arrival students who come for a **longer that 90 days** period have to:

- register in Migration Office in order to get document certifying your legal stay in Lithuania.
- declare the living place in Municipality Office (lt. Seniūnija).

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE IN MIGRATION OFFICE

You need to present following documents to Kaunas Migration Office (address: Šv. Gertrūdos g. 4, Kaunas)

- 1. A valid passport or ID card.
- 2. European health insurance card or private insurance in English or in Lithuanian language.
- 3. Certificate regarding enrolment at LSMU (you will get it from the Study Center); <u>https://lsmusis.lsmuni.lt</u> *Application Personal details Dėl leidimo gyventi LR SUBMIT*
- 4. Declaration that you have sufficient resources to support yourself in English or in Lithuanian language. (Resources may come from your parents, spouse, university, government etc., at least 425 EU/month).
- 5. The public fee 8,60 euro. (Pay by the bank card in the Migration Office).
- An application form (submit your application and documents for the issue of the certificate in person through the Lithuanian Migration Information System MIGRIS: <u>www.migracija.lt</u> – Login – Email – New application – Applications on behalf of natural persons – Select your nationality - I want to get a temporary residence certificate

MORE INFORMATION

Within 5 working days Migration Office will prepare the document certifying your legal stay in Lithuania and will post it to your living address in Lithuania. After reception of this document, you must declare your living place within 7 working days at the Municipality Office.
